Our vision for youth discipleship is based on Colossians 2:6–7, "Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him, rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving." (ESV)

We believe the church has a responsibility to 'root and build up' new believers to grow in their faith. For this to be effective new disciples must be:

- · Living lives which bear evidence of a new life in Christ.
