A WEEKEND WITH REV PHILIP & CATHERINE CAMPBELL – ST COLUMBA'S (OLD PARISH) CHURCH, LEWIS STREET, STORNOWAY

Rev Philip Campbell is recently retired from Coleraine Congregational Church, Co. Londonderry and former evangelist with The Evangelization Society UK. Catherine Campbell was born in Belfast. Catherine trusted Christ as her Saviour in her teens: walking with Him has been her life's delight. Her early working life started during N. Ireland's 'Troubles' as a student nurse in Belfast's famous Royal Victoria Hospital. In 2005 Catherine hung up her nursing uniform for the last time to devote more time to a developing ministry in writing and speaking. Her family situation was the catalyst for her writing, which started by crafting articles for a number of magazines including The Nursing Standard and Woman Alive. Then in 2008 she took the giant leap from writing articles to having her first book published. Under the Rainbow tells the story of Catherine's walk with God while caring for her daughters, and the difficult times after their deaths. Other titles include: Broken Works Best, God Knows Your Name, God Isn't Finished With You Yet, Rainbows For Rainy Days and her recently published book 'CONSIDER HIM'
