PRAYING FOR ONE ANOTHER

The following are prayer points issued by the Mission Board under the Praying For One Another Scheme (PFOA) in the coming week.

Monday 16th January - New City Church, Dunfermline

Our mission is to love God, love his people and love our community - pray that as a loved community of believers we would respond to that love in worship, in loving each other deeply and in loving our neighours as ourselves. Less than 1000 people out of nearly 60000 people in Dunfermline attend gospell churches. Pray that all the evangelical churches in and around Dunfermline would grow with people coming to faith.

Tuesday 17th January - Turkey

As Turkey prepares for important elections, which are due to be held by early summer, pray for political leaders in the country: that they would have wisdom and integrity, and that the Lord would reveal Himself clearly to them as Saviour.

Wednesday 18th January - Grace Church Montrose

We regularly say at the beginning of our services, "Grace is our name and grace is our message". Most importantly then, please pray that the people of our town and surrounding communities would encounter the grace of God through the gospel (including a number of seekers coming to church). And that we as a congregation would be transformed by that same grace.

Thursday 19th January - New City Church, Dunfermline

Our biggest struggle is that we are still in rented premises. They are great, but we'd love our own base to reach out into the community from. Pray New City Church would find a home in the city.

Friday 20th January - Turkey

Give thanks for successful Christmas outreach events in Turkey. Hundreds of people participated, with many hearing the Gospel for the first time. Ask God to open their hearts to the truth of Christ and bring them to know Him.

Saturday 21st January - Grace Church Montrose

Brechin is the closest town to us. There are a few Christians there (including a number who come to Grace) but no healthy gospel church. Would you join us as we pray for a gospel witness in that town to be started and established?

Sunday 22nd January - New City Church, Dunfermline

We're starting a Hope Explored course on 25th January. Pray that seekers and new believers would come and it would be blessed to them.
