PRAYING FOR ONE ANOTHER (16th – 22nd OCTOBER 2023)

Monday 16th October

North Uist

Pray that the Lord would enable us to build on the recent OM Mission week that took place in Uist with volunteers from around the world coming to Uist to engage in evangelistic work. Lots of connections were made and many came along to the various events, pray that seeds planted would bear fruit in the lives of many.

Tuesday 17th October

Turkey

Getting Christian theological training is not straightforward for believers in Turkey. Pray for all those involved in providing training and for those studying. Also for Turkish believers at theological colleges abroad - particularly that they would return to Turkey to serve the Church there.

Wednesday 18th October

Lochgilphead

Give thanks for the new people who have joined and for the positive contribution they have already made to the spiritual vitality of the congregation. Pray that they will find a spiritual home among us.

Thursday 19th October Vision Day

Please pray for the Generation Vision Conference taking place on the 11th of November in Glasgow.
