INTRODUCTION

We are a congregation of the <u>Free Church of Scotland</u>. We gather for public worship on the Lord's Day at 12.00noon and at 6.00pm. We use the <u>ESV version of the Bible</u> in the public worship of God. We use both the <u>Scottish Psalter</u> and <u>Sing Psalms</u> versions of the Psalms for the praise items in our public worship. SUNDAY SERVICES

The 12.00noon service will be taken by Rev Kenneth Ferguson and the 6pm service will be taken by the Minister. At the 12.00noon service, the reading will be from Proverbs 4 with a focus on verse 18. At the 6.00pm service we will commence the second part of a study on The Life of King David. We concluded part one some time ago when we looked at the The King according to God's Heart in the context of the fall of King Saul and Saul's jealousy of David which led to his determination to kill him. The second part of the study is looking at the life of David as a fugitive, fleeing for his own safety. This period of his life takes us up to his coronation as King in 2 Samuel Chapters 2 and 5. The title of the series is 'The Forging of Character in the Path of Adversity.' This Lord's Day we will study I Samuel 21:1-9 and 'The Necessity of Getting Our Priorities Right.'
