Monday I Ith August - Govan

Give thanks for the recent baptisms at Govan. Pray for each person and their families to grow in faith, know God's love and grace deeply, and pray for the church as they seek to disciple them.

Tuesday 12th August - Big Free Rally

Wednesday 13th August - Tearfund: Democratic Republic of Congo

The £125,000 grant from the Scottish Government is supporting three vital interventions: providing cash assistance; delivering dignity kits to women and girls; and helping protect people from potential risks – including gender-based violence. Friday 15th August - Dowanvale
