PAKISTAN, EAST AFRICA AND UKRAINE EMERGENCY APPEALS

The Free Church has sent donations to Pakistan, East Africa, and Ukraine Emergency Appeals. There is a deepening, ongoing crisis in each of these areas and we pray for those affected as we seek in some small way to help alleviate their suffering. The Church, through its Disaster and Relief Fund, is sending £6,000 to Tearfund for their appeal in Pakistan, £5,000 to Tearfund towards their work in alleviating suffering due to the food crisis in
