STUDENT PLACEMENT

As previously announced, Mr Matty Guy will be working in the congregation for six weeks under the Students' Placement Scheme organised by ETS as part of training for the ministry. Matty has just completed the third year

of his four-year course, and this is his second and final placement in preparation for the ministry. He is originally from Northern Ireland but resident in St Andrews since 2016.

This second placement is normally undertaken in a vacant congregation. Along with the requirement for Matty to undertake this Placement, the main purpose of it is to free up the Minister's time to enable him to work on various tasks arising from the decisions of the General Assembly. For these two reasons, Matty will carry out all the ministerial and pastoral tasks of the Minister for the duration of the Placement under the oversight of the Minister and the Kirk Session.

Matty is due to arrive in Shawbost on Friday 24th June with his wife Jody and their new-born baby Billy. They will be staying in Lòn Gorm, North Shawbost, during their time with us. Matty will commence is Placement by taking the services on Sunday 26th June. We pray for their safe arrival and for the Lord to bless and enrich Matty and his family during their time with us in the service of the Lord.

SPONSOR A CAMP

The 2022 Free Church Youth Camps (FCYC) programme offers eleven camps in four different locations across the country. As well as taking part in various activities, games and challenges, campers will learn more about the Bible and its relevance to their lives. The costs of running the Camps Programme have risen significantly in recent months and this has brought its own challenges to the organisers and leaders.

The FCYC organisers operates an 'adopt a camp' scheme. Adopting a camp means that the congregation is given a specific camp to keep in touch with between now and when the camp runs. One of the camp leaders will provide updates for prayer, and you can contact the leader to let them know you're praying and to encourage them. Participating congregations may also make a donation to their adopted camp to help cover leaders' costs or other things, either from church funds or from a fundraising event.

The Deacons Court has agreed to 'adopt' the Renfrew Junior Camp, which runs for a week from Saturday 16th July, and which is for S1-S3 Girls. The Deacons Court also agreed to make a donation of £500 to help cover the costs of this Camp and a fundraising event will be organised in support of this. Katie Gillies is one of the leaders at this Camp and we are delighted that she is taking on this role of sharing her faith and leading others through the ministry of the camps.

The weekly Prayer and Bible Study Meeting will take place on Wednesday 22nd June 2022 at 7.00pm in the Bragar Meeting Hall.


