PRAYER MEETING & BIBLE STUDY

The weekly Prayer and Bible Study meeting will take place in Bragar at 7.00pm this Wednesday, 23rd February 2022 (DV). In line with the revised practice for the Lord's Day services, we continue to observe the one-metre physical distancing but will no longer take a register of those attending the meeting.

SACRAMENT OF THE LORD'S SUPPER

The Kirk Session appointed the Sacrament of the Lord's Supper to be observed and dispensed at the 12.00noon service on Sunday 27th February 2022 (DV). There will be a preparatory service on Friday 25th February at 7.00pm and a thanksgiving service on Sunday evening at 6.00pm. All the services will be in the Church, will be conducted in English, and will be taken by the Minister. We are thankful to the Lord for this opportunity in His providence to restore the Sacrament to the life of the congregation with all its associated benefits and we look to the Lord to make it a blessing. More details on arrangements for the Sacrament are provided below:

The Preliminaries

The Kirk Session will meet on Friday evening after the 7.00pm English service. The Session will be pleased to meet with anyone who desires to profess their faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and sit at the Lord's Table for the first time. The

Session will also receive transference certificates from anyone who wishes to join us from another congregation.

The Kirk Session will appoint one person to cut the bread and one person to fill the wine cups. The persons appointed will wear latex gloves and a face-covering while preparing the bread and filling the wine cups.

Arrangements for the Sacrament

Due to the current COVID-19 Scottish Government restrictions, and the ongoing transmissibility of the virus, the arrangement for the Sacrament of the Lord's Supper will be as follows:

Communion Tokens

It is customary to distribute Communion Tokens to intending communicants. Tokens will not be used or distributed on this occasion. The front section on both sides of the Church will be reserved for the Lord's Table. Intending communicants will be ushered to their seats on entrance to the service.

Individual, Disposable Cups

We will also depart from the usual custom as far as dispensing the Sacrament, and distributing the elements, is concerned. The Common Cup will be placed on the table from which the Sacrament is dispensed. We will use individual, disposable cups for the elements. Each Communion Tray will have two sets of disposable cups – one with the broken (pre-cut piece) bread and one with the wine. ---- We will use one Communion Tray with disposable cups containing the bread and another Communion Tray with disposable cups containing the wine.

Dispensing the Sacrament

We will keep a clear row (pew) between intending Communicants. The Elders will use this row to bring the bread and the wine to communicants – there will be no passing of the communion tray between persons in the pew. Communicants are encouraged to hold on to the disposable cups or place them on the empty seat in front of them until the Elders return with the Trays to collect them.
