Rev. Bob Akroyd, Systematic Theology Lecturer at Edinburgh Theological Seminary, will serve as the Moderator of the General Assembly of the Free Church of Scotland in 2023-24. Our own Minister, Rev Callum Macleod, is Principal Clerk.

Pray that decisions made will continue to lead the church towards the vision of a healthy gospel church for every community.
