THE EARLY CHURCH FATHERS - ST CYRIL OF JERUSALEM

Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment but has passed from death to life. (John 5:24)

Even if you lack faith, or have little faith, the Lord is loving toward humanity; He stoops down to you on your repentance. All you need do is say with a sincere mind, "Lord, I believe, help my unbelief!" (Mark 9:24). However, if you think you truly have faith, but you don't yet have the fullness of faith, you should join with the apostles in saying, "Lord, increase our faith!" (Luke 17:5). So there is something for you to do; but what the Lord does for you is the greatest thing.

The word "faith" may be a single word, but it has two meanings. There is faith relating to doctrine, involving assent on a definite point, beneficial to the soul, as the Lord says: "Whoever hears My words, and believes in Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come under judgment or condemnation: whoever believes in the Son has passed from death to life" (John 5:24). O God's vast compassion! The righteous spent many years in doing what pleased Him; but what they accomplished through many long years of pleasing God, this same blessing Jesus now grants you in a single hour! If you will only believe that Jesus Christ is Lord, and that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved (Rom. 10:9), and be carried into Paradise by Him who took the robber there. Don't doubt whether it's possible; He Himself, who upon holy Golgotha saved the robber after one single hour of belief, will save you too upon your believing.

The second kind of faith is given by Christ as a spiritual gift (1 Cor. 12:8-11)... It doesn't relate primarily to doctrine, but works heavenly miracles. Whoever has this faith will say to a mountain, "Move from here to there," and it will move (Matt. 21:21).

THE LARGER CATECHSIM

Q. 14. How doth God execute his decrees?

A. God executeth his decrees in the works of creation and providence, according to his infallible fore-knowledge, and the free and immutable counsel of his own will. **Eph. 1:11**.

Q. 15. What is the work of creation?

A. The work of creation is that wherein God did in the beginning, by the word of his power, make of nothing the world, and all things therein, for himself, within the space of six days, and all very good. **Gen. 1**; **Heb. 11:3**; **Prov. 16:4**.
