## SUNDAY SERVICES

We are thankful to gather in the Church this Lord's Day for the public worship of God. We meet at 12.00noon and at 6.00pm. Both the services will be conducted in English and taken by the Minister.

### Services this Sunday

At the 12.00noon service we will continue our short study of Lessons from the Return from Exile in the Old Testament. The focus of the service this Lord's Day will be on Nehemiah 4:15-20 and Ephesians 6:10-12 and the title of the sermon is God's Strategy for Kingdom Building. At the 6.00pm service we will consider events at Pentecost in Acts 2:29-41 and the title of the sermon is 'Reversals & Rewards of Kingdom Life.'

#### **COVID Restrictions**

However, we will continue to observe the one-metre physical distancing in our services in the meantime to help allay people's anxieties in public gatherings in the light of the ongoing presence of the COVID-19. We will also continue the practice of taking a register of all those attending our services.

The Sunday School will meet in person in the Hall again this Lord's Day. According to the normal practice, the young people will be in the Church service from 12.00noon until leaving the service for the Sunday School at approximately 12.15pm. The teachers will ensure that all relevant COVID-19 guidance is observed.

We need to be disciple-making more than ever, and we need new disciples to rapidly step up their commitment to the whole life of the church.

There are great social and economic needs, common to areas of relative rural deprivation, which we have tried to help address, but find challenging to continue with an aging congregation. But there is a profound spiritual need and we need to find ways to faithful bring the Good News into this darkness.
